## NOTIFICATION

No. 721LW/LW/1R-8/77.—8th May 1978.—In exercise of the power conferred by section 29 of the Indian Boilers Act, 1923 (5 of 1923), the Governor is pleased to make the following amendment, the same having been published in the "Calcutta Gazette" as required under section 31 of the said Act, in the West Bengal Economiser Rules, 1958 (hereinafter referred to as the said Rules), with effect from the 1st June 1978, namely:

## Amendment

For rule 14 of the said Rules, substitute the following rule, namely:

"14. (1) Fees for issue of renewed certificate: The fees payable for the issue of a renewed certificate shall be calculated on the basis of the economiser rating as shown below:

For economiser rating not exceeding 50	60
For economiser rating exceeding 50 but not exceeding 100	75
For economiser rating exceeding 100 but not exceeding 150	90
For economiser rating exceeding 150 but not exceeding 200	105
For economiser rating exceeding 200 but not exceeding 250	120
For economiser rating exceeding 250 but not exceeding 300	135
For economiser rating exceeding 300 but not exceeding 350	150
For economiser rating exceeding 350 but not exceeding 400	165
For economiser rating exceeding 400 but not exceeding 450	180
For economiser rating exceeding 450 but not exceeding 500	195
For economiser rating exceeding 500 but not exceeding 600	210
For economiser rating exceeding 600 but not exceeding 700	225
For economiser rating exceeding 700 but not exceeding 800	240
For economiser rating exceeding 800 but not exceeding 900	255
For economiser rating exceeding 900 but not exceeding 1000	270

and for every 200 or part thereof of economiser rating exceeding 1000 an additional fee of Rs. 15 shall be charged:

Provided that when any owner is willing to accept a renewal certificate for less than 24 months in order to approximate the date of the annual inspection to the date on which other economisers in the locality are inspected, a certificate for such shorter period as may be necessary for such approximation at the rate of one twenty-fourth of the ordinary fee for each full month, fraction of a month not being reckoned for such calculation.

(2) Fees mentioned in sub-rule (1) shall cover thorough inspection and hydraulic test as required under the regulation.

(3) A second fee shall be levied for re-inspection of a defective economiser and also in case where the inspection of an economiser has commenced but owing to the fault or neglect of the owner or person in charge is not completed within a period of six months from the date of commencement of the inspection.

(4) Duplicate certificates for bona fide purposes may be issued to economiser owners under the order of the Chief Inspector on receipt of a fee of Rs. 10.

(5) (a) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rule (2), an additional fee of Rs. 50 shall be charged for—

- (i) inspection of an economiser,
  - (ii) examination of economiser or part thereof at an aggregate of three of the stages of construction or less as detailed in Appendix J of the Indian Boiler Regulations, 1950,
  - (iii) inspection of feed pipes,
- on a Sunday or public holiday under the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 (26 of 1881), provided that such inspection is made at the request of the owner or the maker of the economiser or feed pipes and with the approval of the Chief Inspector.

(b) The additional fee charged under clause (a) shall be paid in the manner prescribed in rule 3.

**Note:** The Inspector conducting the inspection shall be entitled to an allowance equal to half the additional fee so charged.

(6) Other fees required to accompany applications under clause (f) of section 29 shall be of the following clauses, namely:

- (a) For examination of economiser or parts thereof during construction including endorsement of certificate in Form VIII and where necessary issue of certificate in Form VII of the Indian Boiler Regulations, 1950: This should be calculated at four times the registration fee for an economiser as provided in regulation 533 on the basis of outside surface area in square metre involved.
- (b) Fee for examination of plans and particulars of material, design and construction of economisers shall be calculated at the rate equal to the registration fee as provided in regulation 533. But when a plan, which has been scrutinised and in respect of which alterations have been suggested, is resubmitted for scrutiny, a separate fee on the same scale shall be payable if the plan contains alterations other than those previously suggested.
- (c) Fee to be charged for any other matter which in the opinion of the State Government would involve time and labour as provided for in clause (f) of section 29 but is not prescribed in those rules shall be at such rate as may be determined by the State Government.
